Saratoga Foundation for Innovative Learning (SFIL) is a non-profit organization, comprised of community members, that share a common goal of fostering forward-thinking and creative opportunities in the Saratoga Springs City School District (SSCSD).

## What we've accomplished

SFIL raises funds and distributes grants for programs and equipment that extend the central mission of the SSCSD. In just over three years, SFIL had proudly awarded 22 grants totaling over \$75,000. Grants have included a set of ukuleles and steel drums for Maple Avenue Middle School music students, geocaching equipment for Saratoga Springs High School Physical Education classes, kits and supplies for the Little Passports Program at Division Street Elementary School and the creation of the Geysers Road Elementary School Apple Orchard.
